The successful candidate will bring profound knowledge of (early) clinical development and a successful track record in Phase 1/2 clinical development, and in particular a strong exposure in designing and executing Phase 1 safety/pharmacology and Phase 2 proof-of-concept studies. The position will be Zurich area-based, but for the ideal candidate EU wide commuting could be considered with regular presence in the Swiss office in Wädenswil.

### Your Responsibilities

- Building and leading development capabilities within the organization and for managing/building strong collaborative relationships with KOLs and external service providers
- Developing clinical study protocols and clinical development plans and obtaining cross-functional input to execute on clinical development strategies
- Working in close collaboration with internal functions and designated CROs to ensure quality and timely execution of the clinical programs
- Overseeing the assessment of clinical pharmacology, safety, and efficacy data

### Ideal candidates will have

- Education: an advanced degree in a relevant discipline, with a strong preference for an M.D. qualification or equivalent
- Direct experience as an investigator in oncology would be highly beneficial but not essential
- 8-10+ years relevant experience in (early) clinical development within the pharmaceutical and/or (start-up) biotech environment working in Oncology / Immunology related areas, preferably in Immuno-Oncology - or as an experienced clinical investigator who has been involved in a wide range of programs
- Successful track record of bringing complex compounds through (early) clinical development, in particular design and execution of proof-of-concept studies
- Experience in ensuring proper clinical conduct of study protocols in compliance with GCP and local/global trial regulations, overseeing and providing clinical guidance to CRO medical monitors (and study investigators, as needed) and study teams, and leading the development of study protocols, protocol amendments, and clinical study reports

- Sound and comprehensive knowledge of the drug development process, clinical trial management and vendor oversight and safety reporting
- High scientific acumen with a demonstrated ability to independently evaluate, interpret and present complex scientific data
